

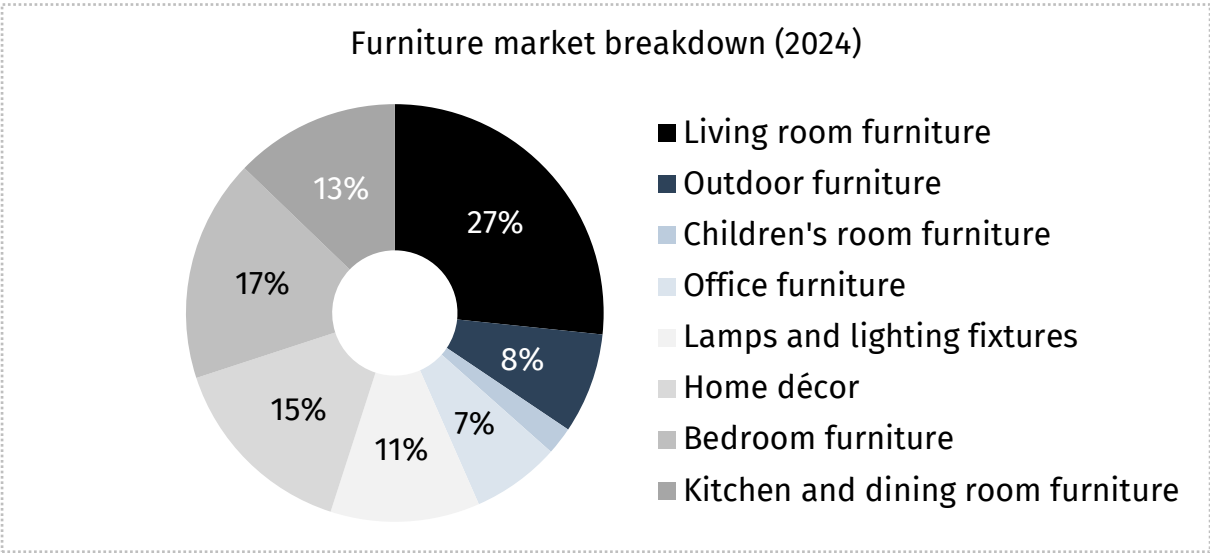
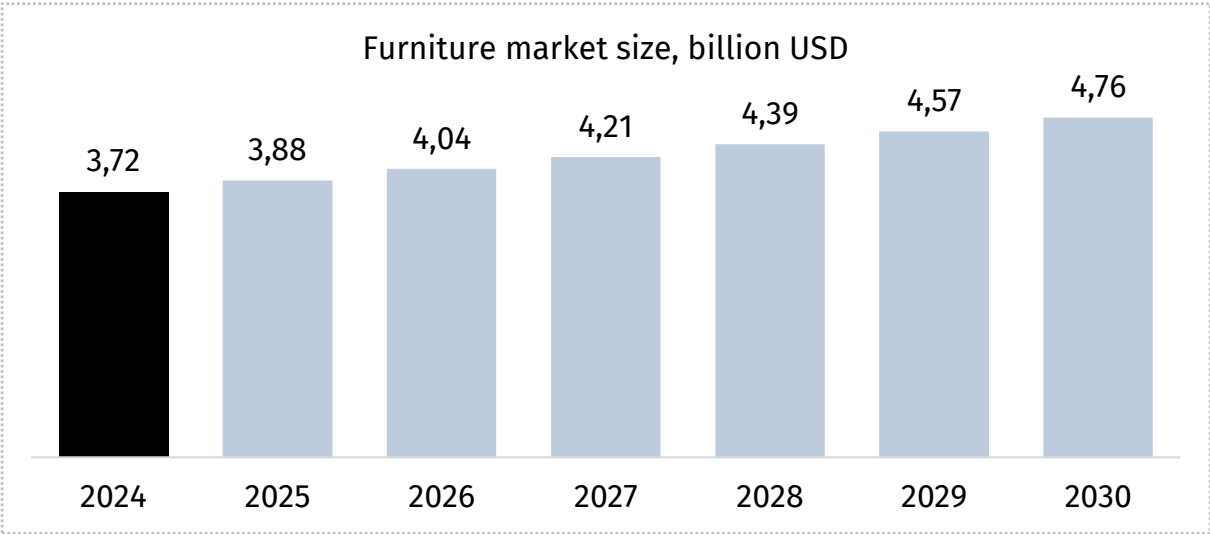

# OVERVIEW OF THE FURNITURE MARKET

**The UAE furniture market is valued at 3.7 billion USD as of 2024. It is expected that from 2025 to 2030, the market volume will grow at a compound annual growth rate of 4.18% per year.**

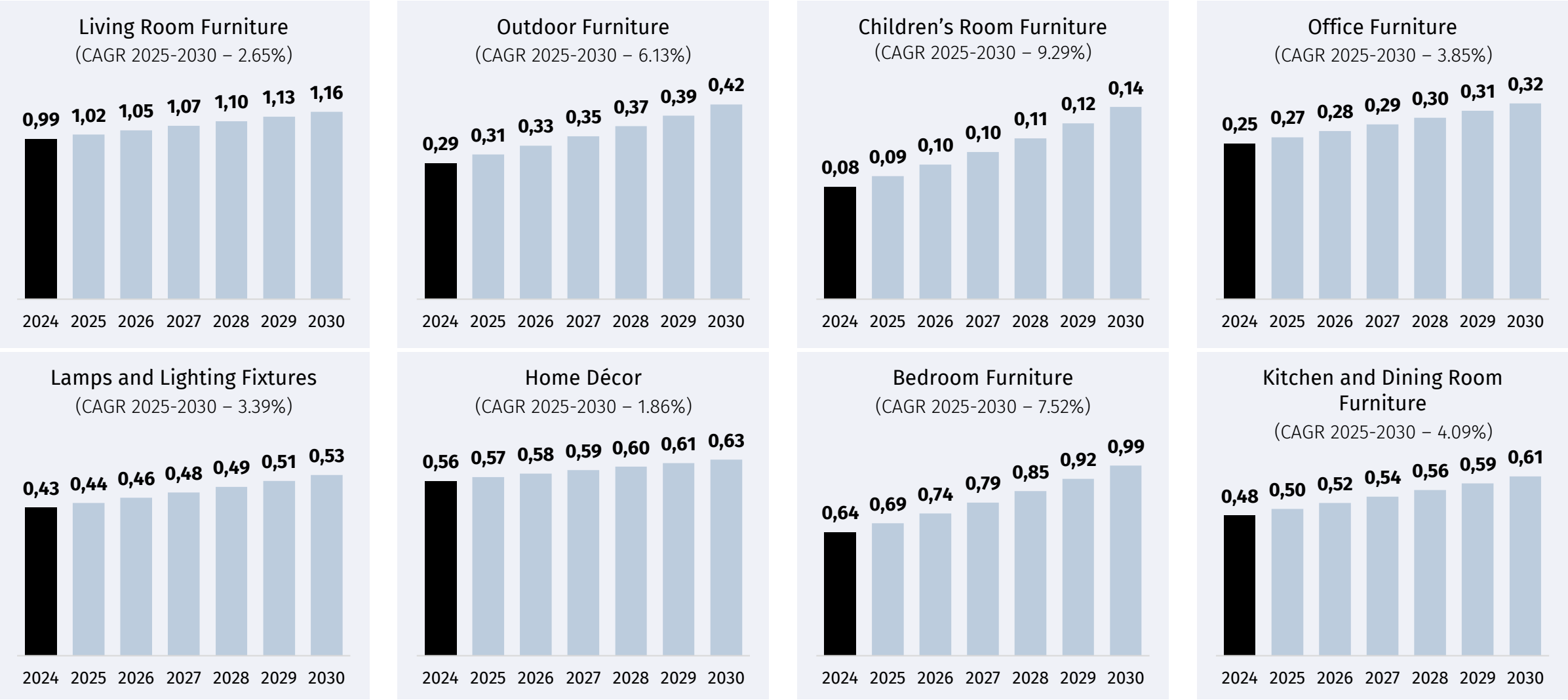
The country satisfies most of its furniture demand, especially for wooden furniture, through imports mainly from countries such as China, Italy, Germany, Poland, Turkey, Malaysia, and Vietnam. The UAE is also becoming a re-export center for furniture to the countries of the Persian Gulf and countries like Kenya and Lebanon.

The main driver of furniture demand growth in the UAE is Dubai, serving as a global business and tourist center. The furniture market in the emirate progresses due to the real estate sector, the development of luxury hotels, and the high purchasing power of consumers.

The development of infrastructure through the government and grand urbanization plans in Abu Dhabi will also have a significant impact on the growth of the furniture market in the country.

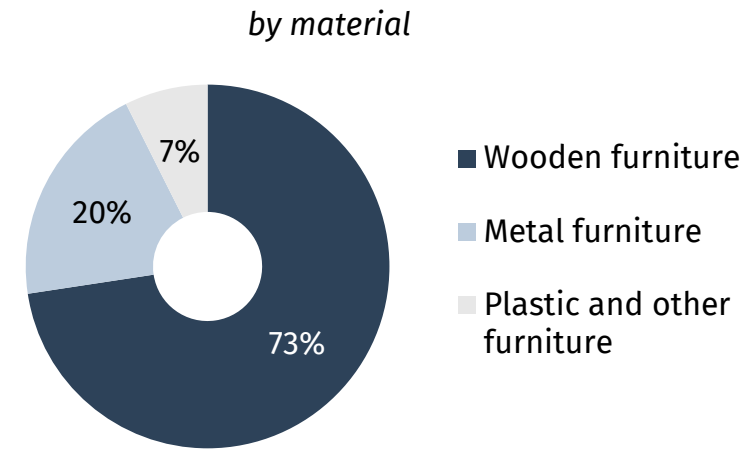
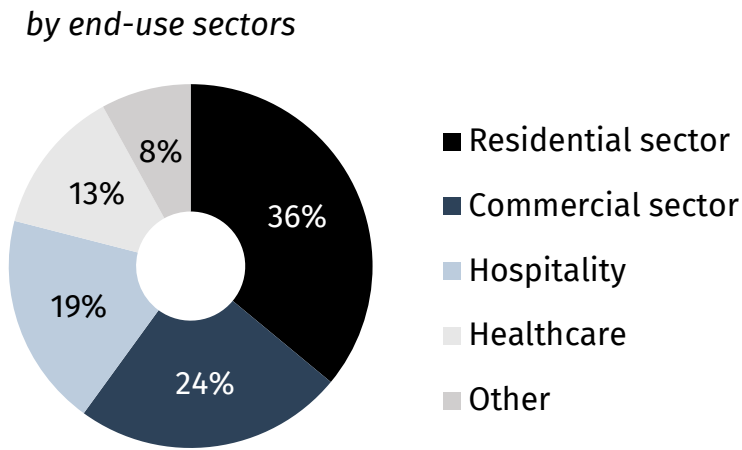
Sizes of the furniture market segments, billion USD

Furniture market breakdown



Residential furniture leads the market, driven by urbanization growth, higher disposable incomes, and increasing preference for personalized and multifunctional furniture suitable for modern apartments and villas.

The expansion of corporate offices, coworking spaces, and growing demand for ergonomic furniture to improve employee productivity stimulate the commercial furniture market, which includes office desks, chairs, and storage furniture.

Furniture for hotels, such as furniture for hotel rooms, lobbies, and outdoor furniture, is in significant demand as tourism in the country flourishes, alongside the growing number of luxury and mid-range hotels.

The growth of the healthcare furniture segment, including hospital beds, seating, and cabinets, is driven by investments in advanced medical facilities and the need for durable, easy-to-clean, and functional designs tailored to healthcare environments.

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## **IKEA**

An international manufacturing and retail group, one of the world leaders in the furniture market. The first store in the UAE opened in 1991. Currently, stores are located in Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Al Ain, Fujairah, and Sharjah. The company's franchisee in the UAE is Al-Futtaim.



## **Pan Home**

A UAE-founded brand of budget-segment retail furniture with over 30 years of history. The company has more than 20 showrooms across the Gulf countries. In late 2022, the company underwent rebranding; the former name was Pan Emirates Home Furnishings.



## **Home Centre**

A major furniture retailer in the MENA region and India, founded in 1995 in the UAE. The company is part of the Landmark Group conglomerate, which operates retail businesses in various product segments.

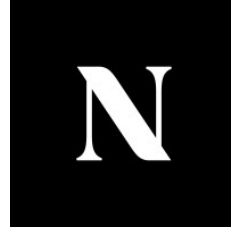
# FURNITURE COMPANIES

## Natuzzi

# TRENDS IN THE FURNITURE MARKET

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- ① The UAE furniture market demonstrates steady growth, driven by a combination of urbanization, demographic shifts, changing consumer preferences, and technological advancements.
- ② Smart furniture, automated systems, energy-efficient solutions, and furniture items featuring built-in technological functions, including USB ports and wireless charging stations, are gaining popularity.
- ③ Manufacturers are responding to demand for more eco-friendly and sustainable furniture by using renewable and recyclable materials in design, such as wood sourced from sustainable origins and more environmentally friendly upholstery options. Another indicator of sustainability is the trend toward minimalist, functional furniture design, which ensures greater energy efficiency and waste reduction.
- ④ Demand for luxury furniture has increased due to the growth in the number of high-end residential complexes, hotels, and commercial real estate in cities such as Dubai and Abu Dhabi. Brands respond by offering custom solutions and bespoke projects. International furniture designers and global high-end brands continue to increase their presence in the UAE, offering refined, luxurious collections.
- ⑤ There is growing internet and social media penetration in the UAE, which increases opportunities for online sales of furniture products in the country. Retailers respond by strengthening their digital presence and implementing omnichannel strategies, including virtual reality technologies for product visualization and seamless online-to-offline transition. Major furniture retailers invest in e-commerce platforms, mobile applications, and digital payment solutions to provide a convenient shopping experience while maintaining competitive pricing strategies.



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
